Building Evacuation

1.0 Introduction

This document provides guidelines for the evacuation of Volunteer Marine Rescue Brisbane buildings.

3.0 Detailed Information

- a) In the event of the evacuation of the building becoming necessary, the senior person present will ensure that all persons on the premises are made aware of the evacuation and are conversant with the assembly point.
- b) The senior person present will ensure that the relevant emergency authority is notified as soon as possible.
- c) The assembly point in the event of a building evacuation shall be the area adjacent to the fish cleaning table near the walkway entrance to the pontoon. A green "Assembly Area" sign is erected to indicate this area.
- d) The senior person present shall take a count of persons at the assembly point to ensure that all persons are accounted for.
- e) Evacuation diagrams are located on various walls within the upstairs Clubhouse and should be studied by all personnel and visitors.

4.0 Summary

By following these guidelines the evacuation of the buildings should be carried out with due regard to the safety of all persons.
