### To the Practitioner Concerned

One of our valued active members ..... is currently under your care and has indicated a desire to return to active duty.

Below is a list of possible duties that an active member may encounter while in the role of a Volunteer Marine rescuer. We would be pleased if you could confirm whether or not this Member is fully recovered and allowed to perform these possible duties. Any further comments would also be appreciated.

Some of the conditions encountered include:

- Embarking and disembarking from the rescue vessel to a pontoon or jetty
- Unfavourable weather conditions and rough seas
- Nighttime operations
- Activities may be stressful to some people
- May include long hours at sea (up to 4 to 5 hours)
- May have to enter the water
- May have to board other vessels at sea

Depending upon your recommendations the Member may be able to return to active duty of a restricted nature such as a land based radio operator.

We, at VMR Brisbane are keen to assist with the rehabilitation of any of our members following serious illness or injury and the comments you provide are greatly appreciated and acted upon accordingly.
